4. Can you name the following movement picture below? (One point)

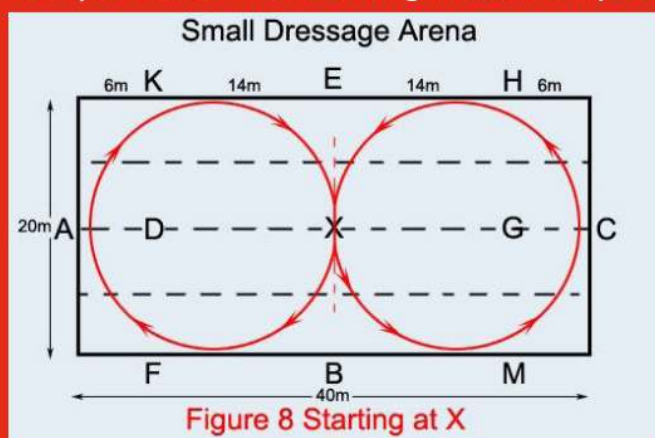


Figure of eight
